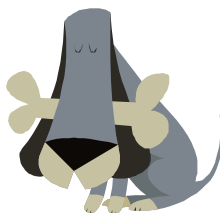

1. "Dog" means either sex.
2. A qualifying score is required for all Trophies in the Regular Classes.
3. Trophies specific to a particular Class will be awarded after judging of that Class.
4. Trophies **not** specific to a particular Class will be awarded after judging of all Dogs eligible for that Trophy.
5. Either the Dog's handler or owner, or designee thereof, must be present to receive the Trophy when it is awarded.
6. Trophies not picked up by the night of the Trials will be **FORFEITED**.
7. No Trophies will be mailed.
8. GWBdFC reserves the right to substitute an appropriate trophy should the offered trophy not be available.

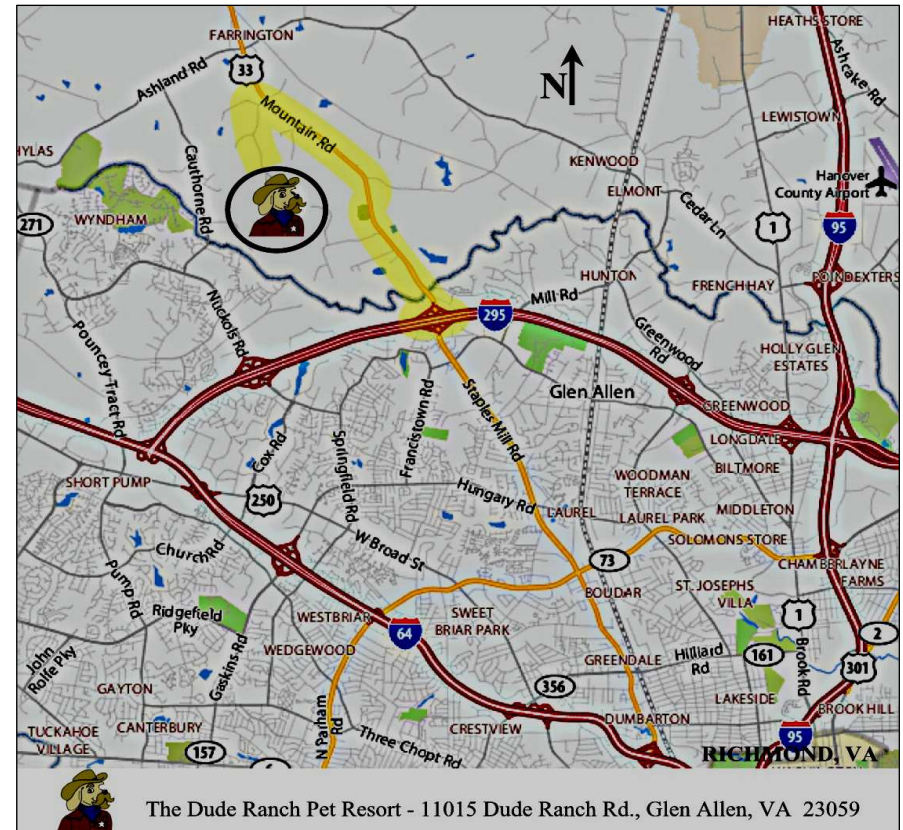

ENTRY SUBMISSION: Telegraph, telephone, faxed, electronic and unsigned entries will  
**not** be accepted.

ENTRY FEES: Entries received without correct entry fees will **not** be accepted.

ENTRY FORMS: Entries not on official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms  
without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse of the official AKC entry form will **not** be  
accepted.

ENTRY FORM ERRORS: Owners are responsible for errors in filling out the entry  
form(s) regardless of who may have made such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in  
the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

ENTRY CONDITIONS: No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which  
specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

ENTRY ACKNOWLEDGEMENT: Receipt of entries will be acknowledged as soon as  
practical by mail (or by E-mail if specified on the Entry Form) with tickets and/or  
identification cards. The person accompanying a dog must show tickets and/or  
identification before a dog will be received. If exhibitor does not receive this  
acknowledgement within a reasonable time, please notify the Trial Secretary.

ENTRY FEE REFUNDS: Entry fees shall **not** be refunded in the event that a dog is absent,  
disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of  
the Trial Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or weather emergencies or  
other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the  
show, **no** refund of entry fees will be made.

Trials.

Consult judging program for time of judging. Show hours are from 8:00am to 6:00pm on  
Saturday, November 8, 2008.

Dogs may arrive any time during show hours prior to their scheduled time of judging.  
Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

Judges will **not** wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners and agents alone are  
responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called  
to be judged.

All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being  
judged.

No dog may be permanently removed from the show before it is judged except by consent  
of the Trial Secretary upon a Veterinarian's recommendation of removal.
